## Important Information for Student Registration:

- Scouts in grades 9, 10, 11, or 12
- Participants responsible for covering \$100 of their \$450 tuition; remaining fee is covered by a grant
- Scouts cover costs of travel to and from Philadelphia
- Freedoms Foundation provides transportation to and from the Philadelphia Airport and 30th Street Station



Participants in this program must demonstrate leadership abilities and be active within their Boy Scout Troop, Varsity Scout team, Venturing Crew, or Sea Scout ship. Scouts must have reached the rank of **Eagle Scout** or received the **Silver Award** or the **Quartermaster Award**

Scouts should also be involved in programs such as the Order of the Arrow, summer camp staff, high-adventure programs, and peer leadership training. Besides Scouting, youth participants should also demonstrate leadership roles in their community of worship, school activities, athletic endeavors, and volunteer work.

A council may nominate up to five participants they deem qualified. Although not required, adult chaperones are welcome, and a portion of their participation fee is covered by the Freedoms Foundation Scholarship.
